ARTICLE 4. SCHEDULE AND MILESTONES is amended to the following for the last three milestones:


<p>EAI Launch Vehicle Compatibility Review EAI will present a status review of launch vehicle compatibility evaluations performed to date.</p> <p>EAI documentation provided will include a summary presentation describing an assessment of the compatibility of EAI’s spacecraft with the U.S. based launch vehicle with respect to loads and dynamics based on available published information.</p>	<p>June 2012</p>
<p>EAI Test Status Review EAI will present a status review of physical testing activities.</p> <p>EAI documentation provided will include a summary presentation and supporting documentation describing the physical characteristics of the EAI Re-usable Re-entry Vehicle (RRV) and the rationale and concepts for RRV structure pressure testing and Non Destructive Evaluation (NDE).</p>	<p>May 2012</p>
<p>EAI Design Status Review EAI will present a status review of progress to date focused on integration planning and provide an update on hardware development activities.</p> <p>EAI documentation provided will include a summary presentation of EAI spacecraft development status and related activities.</p>	<p>May 2012</p>
